He serves as Adjunct Assistant Professor for Climate Solutions at HKUST and is a lecturer in other sustainability executive education programmes and MBA modules focusing on climate change related topics. Outside of academia, he helps to lead the Climate & Sustainability team at Deloitte Hong Kong where he leads various projects in the field of sustainability and climate change for a wide range of industries – topics include sustainable finance, climate risks, consumer preferences, developing new low-carbon business models as well as decarbonisation strategies and pathways.

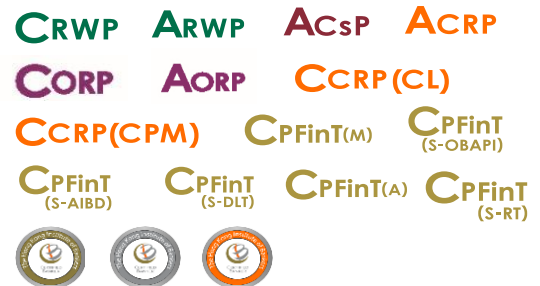
